Parade line up is at 5:30PM beginning at the intersection of Main Street and Maddox Boulevard. North on Main Street toward the Chincoteague Combined School - some entries will be held in the school parking lot. Please know your line number and follow directions of the volunteers to your designated holding area.

Note: Equestrian groups are provided a special designated space off the line-up route but near their place in line... the areas are on the grass, near lighting and rest rooms with adequate parking for your trailers. Please plan to congregate at these designated areas and you will be directed to your place in line as it approaches your group.

**Equestrian groups must provide a person/vehicle to clean up after their horses,
so the road is clean for those that follow.**

Parade starts at 6:00 PM

Voting will take place at the Judge's Stand in front of the Chincoteague Island Library. Entries should pause at the Judge's Stand and may stop at the for a short performance.

After Parade: Participants are welcome to stop at the Chincoteague American Legion Post 159, 4023 Main Street to visit Santa while enjoying hot dogs and refreshments provided by the Kiwanis Club of Chincoteague.

Regulations and Liability Waiver

All Chincoteague Old-Fashioned Christmas Parade entries must submit a parade entry form and completed Parade Regulations and Liability Waiver to the Chincoteague Chamber of Commerce prior to parade date to participate. Walk-ons and entries with no waiver on file, will not be permitted to participate.

Parade Rules:

- All parade participants must be registered with the Chincoteague Chamber of Commerce.
- All aspects of entry must be appropriate for all ages, as parade is a family-friendly event.
- All motorized vehicles must be registered, insured, and driven by a licensed operator.
- Parade participants riding on a parade entry must remain seated, or if standing be secured in place by an adequate safety strap or harness, throughout entire length of parade.
- Throwing candy or other items is prohibited. Items must be handed to spectators and the distribution is the sole responsibility and liability of the parade participant.
- Animals, including but not limited to horses, ponies, dogs, and goats, must be controlled by handlers at all times and participants assume full responsibility and liability for their actions.
- Santas are not permitted in the parade, as the real Santa has already accepted our invitation!
- Parade officials have authority to remove any parade entry for violation of any of the above rules.

Waiver:

The undersigned acknowledges that they shall inspect all aspects of their parade entry prior to usage and ensure said entry is safe for its use and purposes, in good state of repair, and there are no problems posing threat of injury of any kind to any volunteers, employees, agents, and/or guests of the undersigned, or to any third party.

The undersigned further acknowledges that the activities of the parade (including pre- and post-parade activities) are dangerous and involve risk of serious injury, death, and/or property damage. The undersigned agrees on behalf of their parade entry, to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Chincoteague Chamber of Commerce and its affiliates, employees, agents, and representatives connected with the parade for any personal injuries, property loss, or damage suffered by any person as a result of the actions of the parade participants connected to the group, float, or individuals.
